Although,She was unable to recognize her disease Asha and her husband suffered a lot due to her blindness and their marriage was at stake due to the same. She was the victim of social negligence. Unfortunately, she was unwilling to have surgery on both the eyes and got irritated when anybody asked for surgery.Fortunately, free eye camp was organized on behalf of Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya in Satna and her husbandHarilal came to know about this by his fellowmen. Ultimately her husband took a decision and came along with her to Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya at free eye camp in Satna. When she arrived to the hospital she was unwilling to have surgery and was very uncooperative during the whole process. Thrice she was sent back to the ward from OT due to her uncooperation and irritable behaviour. Lastly, under General Aneasthesia the right eye was operated and she got satisfactory result. Ashacan now see the whole world and she got 6/60 Post op vision (Pre op vision was PL-PR; almost blind) and she is very happy and contented now, somehow her mental disability and anxious attitude has been rectified and she has responded to the staff with a pleasant smile and gave a feedback to come again to get the surgery done on the left eye.
