

## Case story

Radha Devi, a 13 years old girl, is residing in Birsinghpur block of Satna district. She is studying in 08<sup>th</sup> standard in Shaskiya Vidhyalaya, Sukawah. Her father is a driver and her mother is a housewife. Apart from herself, she has six siblings i.e. three sisters and three brothers. Her father is the only earning member in his family.

During the counseling with her uncle, with whom she visited the hospital for the treatment, she informed that while cutting the wood from the nearby jungle from her home, she met with an accident injuring her right eye badly. A piece of wood got pierced in her eye leading to corneal tear. When she reached her home, her parents noticed the injury and provided her with some home remedy. As the day passed, her eye condition got worsened which made the family members concerned for her future. The family was also not having enough money, so that they can get her child treated in a hospital.

When her uncle was informed about her eye condition, he brought Radha to our hospital for the treatment. He informed our team members about the lack of funds for the treatment. The counselor informed him that the surgery will be done for free with the support of ORBIS International under the School Screening Programme. During her last follow up visit, she was advised to continue her spectacles with a power of -0.75 D in her left eye and +0.25 in her right eye respectively.
