

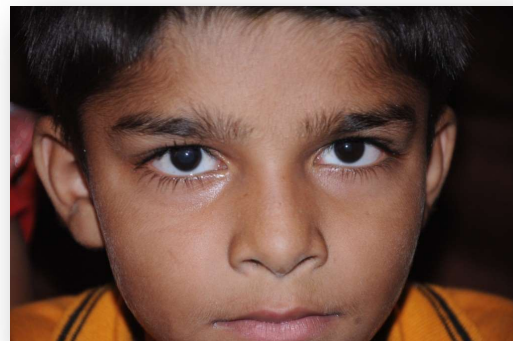
Case story

Raj Tripathi, a 07 years old boy, is residing in Nagod block of Satna district. He is studying in 01st standard in H.S.G.M Madai Singhpur, Nagod. His father is a labour and working in Mumbai and his mother is a housewife. He is the only child of his parents.

While discussing with his, we came to know about his story of developing cataract in his right eye. His grandfather and mother informed that he developed a white patch in his right eye since his birth. Post that they took him to a quack, for which he informed that he is having cataract in his right eye which cannot be treated. This statement of the quack made the parents to lose their hope for visiting any other health facility.

With his increasing age he got used to in using his only left eye for his day to day activities. He also got admitted in a nearby school for his studies.

His parents informed that during the school screening being done by the team of Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya, Raj was diagnosed with congenital cataract and was provided with a referral card to visit our hospital for the treatment. Post examination by the doctors, they informed the parents that he can again recover his vision with a surgery. With a detailed counseling session being done with Raj's grandfather and mother, they agreed to get his right eye operated at our hospital. He got his right eye operated on 22nd of August 2017 respectively. The counselor informed him that the surgery will be done for free with the support of ORBIS International under the School Screening Programme. During his last follow up visit, he was advised spectacle with a power of +0.75 & +2.0 D respectively.
