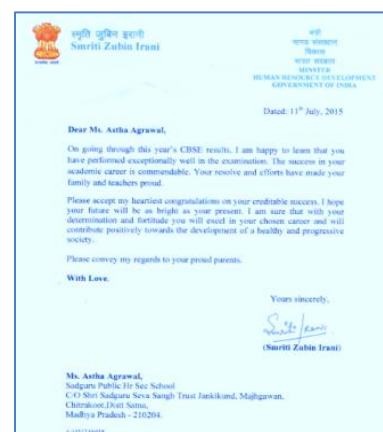
Guru Purnima : Scholarship Distribution, 31st July 2015

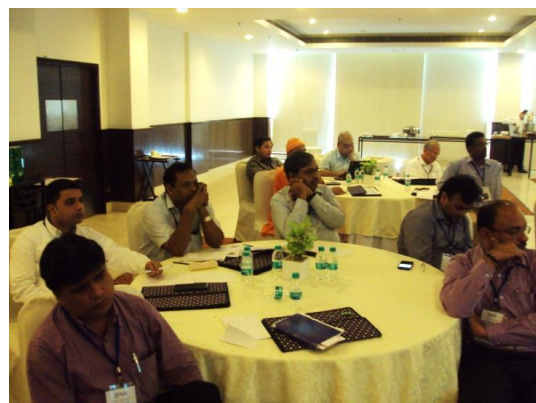
